Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Black Hills National
5 Forest and Rocky Mountain Research Station Improve6 ment Act".

# 7 SEC. 2. SALE OR EXCHANGE OF LAND, BLACK HILLS NA8 TIONAL FOREST, SOUTH DAKOTA.

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Agriculture (re-10 ferred to in this section as the "Secretary") may, under 11 such terms and conditions as the Secretary may prescribe, 12 sell or exchange any right, title, and interest of the United 13 States in and to the approximately 362 acres contained 14 in the following parcels of land in the State of South Da-15 kota:

16 (1) Tract BLKH-1 "Spearfish Dwelling" (ap17 proximately 0.24 acres); N<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> of Lot 8 and Lot 9 of
18 Block 16, Section 10, T6N, R2E, Black Hills Merid19 ian.

20 (2) Tract BLKH-2 "Deadwood Garage" (ap21 proximately 0.12 acres); Lots 9 and 11 of Block 34,
22 Section 23, T5N, R3E, Black Hills Meridian.

23 (3) Tract BLKH-3 "Deadwood Dwellings" (ap24 proximately 0.32 acres); Lots 12-16, inclusive, of

Block 44, Section 23, T5N, R3E, Black Hill Merid ian.

23 (8) Tract BLKH-9 "Allen Gulch Properties"
24 (approximately 21 acres); Lot 14 less and except

Tract STA #0029, Section 25, and Lot 1, Section
 36, T1S, R4E, Black Hills Meridian.

3 (9) Tract BLKH-10 "Custer Ranger District
4 Office" (approximately 0.39 acres); Lots 4 and 9 of
5 Block 125 and the East 15 feet of the vacated
6 north/south alley adjacent to Lot 4, City of Custer,
7 Section 26, T3S, R4E, Black Hills Meridian.

8 (b) TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.—The Secretary may
9 make technical corrections to the legal descriptions in
10 paragraphs (1) through (9) of subsection (a).

(c) APPLICABLE AUTHORITIES.—Except as otherwise
provided in this section, any sale or exchange of land described in subsection (a) shall be subject to laws (including
regulations) applicable to the conveyance and acquisition
of land for National Forest System purposes.

(d) CASH EQUALIZATION.—Notwithstanding any
other provision of law, the Secretary may accept cash
equalization payments in excess of 25 percent of the total
value of the land described in subsection (a) from any exchange under subsection (a).

21 (e) Solicitations of Offers.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—In carrying out this section,
the Secretary may use solicitations of offers for sale
or exchange under this section on such terms and
conditions as the Secretary may prescribe.

1	(2) Rejection of offers.—The Secretary
2	may reject any offer under this section if the Sec-
3	retary determines that the offer is not adequate or
4	not in the public interest.
5	(f) DISPOSITION OF FUNDS.—Any funds received by
6	the Secretary from a sale under this section or as cash
7	equalization payments from an exchange under this
8	section—
9	(1) shall be deposited into the fund established
10	by Public Law 90–171 (commonly known as the
11	"Sisk Act") (16 U.S.C. 484a); and
12	(2) shall be available for expenditure, on appro-
13	priation, for—
14	(A) the acquisition from willing sellers of
15	land and interests in land in the State of South
16	Dakota; and
17	(B) the acquisition or construction of ad-
18	ministrative improvements in connection with
19	the Black Hills National Forest.
20	(g) Authorization of Appropriations.—There
21	are authorized to be appropriated such sums as are nec-
22	essary to carry out this section.

# 1SEC. 3. REPLACEMENT LABORATORY, ROCKY MOUNTAIN2RESEARCH STATION, RAPID CITY, SOUTH DA-3KOTA.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—There are authorized to be appro-5 priated to the Secretary of Agriculture \$2,100,000 for a laboratory facility for the Rocky Mountain Research Sta-6 7 tion in Rapid City, South Dakota, to replace the obsolete 8 laboratory capability at the research station. The replace-9 ment facility shall be colocated with at least one of the administrative improvements for the Black Hills National 10 11 Forest acquired or constructed under the authority of section 2(f)(2)(B). 12

(b) CONDITIONS ON ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY.—
14 No funds available to carry out this section may be used
15 to purchase or otherwise acquire property unless—

16 (1) the acquisition is from willing sellers; and

17 (2) the property is located within the bound-18 aries of the State of South Dakota.
