A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of Agriculture to sell or exchange all or part of certain administrative sites and other land in the Black Hills National Forest and to use funds derived from the sale or exchange to acquire replacement sites and to acquire or construct administrative improvements in connection with the Black Hills National Forest.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Black Hills National
5 Forest and Rocky Mountain Research Station Improvement
6 Act".

7 SEC. 2. SALE OR EXCHANGE OF LAND, BLACK HILLS NA8 TIONAL FOREST, SOUTH DAKOTA.

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Agriculture (referred to in this section as the "Secretary") may, under 10 11 such terms and conditions as the Secretary may prescribe, sell or exchange any right, title, and interest of the United 12 13 States in and to the approximately 362 acres contained in 14 the following parcels of land in the State of South Dakota: 15 (1) Tract BLKH-1 "Spearfish Dwelling" (approximately 0.24 acres); $N^{1/2}$ of Lot 8 and Lot 9 of 16 17 Block 16, Section 10, T6N, R2E, Black Hills Merid-18 ian.

(2) Tract BLKH-2 "Deadwood Garage" (ap proximately 0.12 acres); Lots 9 and 11 of Block 34,
 Section 23, T5N, R3E, Black Hills Meridian.

22 (3) Tract BLKH-3 "Deadwood Dwellings" (ap23 proximately 0.32 acres); Lots 12-16, inclusive, of

Block 44, Section 23, T5N, R3E, Black Hill Merid ian.

6 (b) TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.—The Secretary may
7 make technical corrections to the legal descriptions in para8 graphs (1) through (9) of subsection (a).

9 (c) APPLICABLE AUTHORITIES.—Except as otherwise 10 provided in this section, any sale or exchange of land de-11 scribed in subsection (a) shall be subject to laws (including 12 regulations) applicable to the conveyance and acquisition 13 of land for National Forest System purposes.

(d) CASH EQUALIZATION.—Notwithstanding any other
provision of law, the Secretary may accept cash equalization payments in excess of 25 percent of the total value
of the land described in subsection (a) from any exchange
under subsection (a).

19 (e) SOLICITATIONS OF OFFERS.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—In carrying out this section,
the Secretary may use solicitations of offers for sale
or exchange under this section on such terms and conditions as the Secretary may prescribe.

24 (2) REJECTION OF OFFERS.—The Secretary may
25 reject any offer under this section if the Secretary de-

1	termines that the offer is not adequate or not in the
2	public interest.
3	(f) DISPOSITION OF FUNDS.—Any funds received by
4	the Secretary from a sale under this section or as cash
5	equalization payments from an exchange under this
6	section—
7	(1) shall be deposited into the fund established by
8	Public Law 90–171 (commonly known as the "Sisk
9	Act") (16 U.S.C. 484a); and
10	(2) shall be available for expenditure, on appro-
11	priation, for—
12	(A) the acquisition from willing sellers of
13	land and interests in land in the State of South
14	Dakota; and
15	(B) the acquisition or construction of ad-
16	ministrative improvements in connection with
17	the Black Hills National Forest.
18	(g) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There are
19	authorized to be appropriated such sums as are necessary
20	to carry out this section.
21	SEC. 3. REPLACEMENT LABORATORY, ROCKY MOUNTAIN
22	RESEARCH STATION, RAPID CITY, SOUTH DA-
23	KOTA.
24	(a) IN GENERAL.—There are authorized to be appro-
25	priated to the Secretary of Agriculture \$2,100,000 for a lab-

oratory facility for the Rocky Mountain Research Station
 in Rapid City, South Dakota, to replace the obsolete labora tory capability at the research station. The replacement fa cility shall be colocated with at least one of the administra tive improvements for the Black Hills National Forest ac quired or constructed under the authority of section
 2(f)(2)(B).

8 (b) CONDITIONS ON ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY.—No
9 funds available to carry out this section may be used to
10 purchase or otherwise acquire property unless—

11 (1) the acquisition is from willing sellers; and

(2) the property is located within the boundaries
of the State of South Dakota.
