A BILL

To limit the amount of assistance for Egypt under the "Foreign Military Financing Program" account for fiscal year 2001.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. FINDINGS AND PURPOSE.
4	(a) FINDINGS.—The Congress finds the following:
5	(1) On October 31, 1999, Egypt Air Flight 990
6	crashed in international waters off the Atlantic coast
7	of the United States.
8	(2) 217 individuals died in the Egypt Air Flight

990 crash, of which 101 were United States citizens.

I	(3) The Government of Egypt requested that
2	the United States Government conduct the investiga-
3	tion regarding this accident.
4	(4) The estimated cost to the United States
5	taxpayers for this investigation is \$18,500,000.
6	(5) The Government of Egypt has not paid or
7	offered to pay any of the costs of the investigation.
8	(b) Purpose.—The purpose of this Act therefore is
9	to deduct one-half of the amount of the cost of the inves-
10	tigation of the Egypt Air Flight 990 crash from the an-
11	nual \$1,300,000,000 United States Foreign Military Fi-
12	nancing Program assistance provided to the Government
13	of Egypt for fiscal year 2001.
14	SEC. 3. LIMITATION ON FOREIGN MILITARY FINANCING
15	PROGRAM ASSISTANCE FOR EGYPT.
16	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, not more
17	than \$1,290,750,000 may be made available for assistance
18	for Egypt for fiscal year 2001 under the "Foreign Military
19	Financing Program" account under section 23 of the
20	Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2763).
