3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Bend Feed Canal Pipe-

5 line Project Act of 2000".

6 SEC. 2. FEDERAL PARTICIPATION.

7 (a) The Secretary of the Interior, in cooperation with
8 the Tumalo Irrigation District (referred to in this section
9 as the "District"), is authorized to participate in the plan-

ning, design, and construction of the Bend Feed Canal
 Pipeline Project, Oregon.

3 (b) The Federal share of the costs of the project shall
4 not exceed 50 percent of the total, and shall be non5 reimbursable. The District shall receive credit from the
6 Secretary toward the District's share of the project for
7 any funds the District has provided toward the design,
8 planning, or construction prior to the enactment of this
9 Act.

(c) Funds received under this Act shall not be considered a supplemental or additional benefit under the Act
of June 17, 1902 (82 Stat. 388), and all Acts amendatory
thereof or supplementary thereto.

14 (d) Title to facilities constructed under this Act will15 be held by the District.

(e) Operations and maintenance of the facilities willbe the responsibility of the District.

18 (f) There are authorized to be appropriated
19 \$2,500,000 for the Federal share of the activities author20 ized under this Act.

(g) The Bureau of Reclamation shall not charge the
District more than one percent of the project cost for carrying out administrative or oversight activities under this
Act.
