A BILL

To limit the age restrictions imposed by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration for the issuance or renewal of certain airman certificates, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON AGE RESTRICTIONS.**

4 Section 44703 of title 49, United States Code, is
5 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
6 section:

7 “(g) **LIMITATION ON AGE RESTRICTIONS.**—Notwith-
8 standing any other provision of law, the Administrator of

1 the Federal Aviation Administration may not, solely by
2 reason of a person's age, if such person is less than 65
3 years old—

4 “(1) refuse to issue to, or renew for, such per-
5 son an airman certificate for the operation of air-
6 craft engaged in operations under part 121 of title
7 14, Code of Federal Regulations; or

8 “(2) require an air carrier to terminate the em-
9 ployment of, or refuse to employ, such person as a
10 pilot on such an aircraft owned or operated by the
11 air carrier.”.
