A BILL

To provide for the implementation of the provisions of law allowing members of the uniformed services to participate in the Thrift Savings Plan.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Military Thrift Savings
5 Plan Implementation Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORITY TO IMPLEMENT.**

7 For purposes of subtitle F of title VI of the National
8 Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2000 (Public

1 Law 106–65; 113 Stat. 670 and following), both of the
2 conditions under section 663(b)(1) of such Act shall be
3 considered met as of such date (as soon as practicable
4 after the date of enactment of this Act) as the Executive
5 Director of the Federal Retirement Thrift Investment
6 Board shall determine.
