- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Military Thrift Savings
- 5 Plan Implementation Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. AUTHORITY TO IMPLEMENT.
- 7 For purposes of subtitle F of title VI of the National
- 8 Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2000 (Public
