To amend title 38, United States Code, to establish a presumption of service connection for the occurrence of hepatitis C in certain veterans.

- 3 SECTION 1. PRESUMPTION OF SERVICE CONNECTION FOR
- 4 OCCURRENCE OF HEPATITIS C IN CERTAIN
- 5 VETERANS.
- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 11 of
- 7 title 38, United States Code, is amended by adding at the
- 8 end the following new section:

1	"§ 1119. Presumption of service connection for hepa-
2	titis C
3	"For purposes of sections 1110 and 1113 of this title,
4	and subject to section 1113 of this title, the disease of
5	hepatitis C becoming manifest in a veteran shall be consid-
6	ered to have been incurred in or aggravated by active mili-
7	tary, naval, or air service, notwithstanding that there is
8	no record of evidence of such illness during the period of
9	such service if it is shown that during such service the
10	veteran experienced one or more of the following:
11	"(1) Transfusion of blood or blood products be-
12	fore December 31, 1992.
13	"(2) Hemodialysis.".
14	(b) Clerical Amendment.—The table of sections
15	at the beginning of such chapter is amended by inserting
16	after the item relating to section 1118 the following new
17	item:

"1119. Presumption of service connection for hepatitis C.".
