1413(d)(2) of title 10, United States Code, is amended

- 1 by striking "disabling—" and all that follows in that sec-
- 2 tion and inserting "disabling under the standard schedule
- 3 of rating disabilities in use by the Department of Veterans
- 4 Affairs.".
- 5 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 6 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to payments of ben-
- 7 efits under section 1413 of title 10, United States Code,
- 8 for months beginning on or after the date of the enact-
- 9 ment of this Act.
