AN ACT

To redesignate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 200 West 2nd Street in Royal Oak, Michigan, as the “William S. Broomfield Post Office Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION.**

4 The facility of the United States Postal Service lo-
5 cated at 200 West 2nd Street in Royal Oak, Michigan,
6 and known as the Royal Oak Post Office, shall be known
7 and designated as the “William S. Broomfield Post Office
8 Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the facility
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
5 to the “William S. Broomfield Post Office Building”.

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
