1	SECTION 1. INCREASE IN MEDICARE PAYMENT FOR MEN-
2	TAL HEALTH SERVICES PROVIDED TO QUALI-
3	FIED MEDICARE BENEFICIARIES WHO RE-
4	SIDE IN CONGREGATE RESIDENCES.
5	(a) In General.—Section 1833(c) of the Social Se-
6	curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395l(c)) is amended—
7	(1) by inserting "(1)" after "(c)";
8	(2) by inserting "subject to paragraph (2),"
9	after "Notwithstanding any other provision of this
10	part,";
11	(3) by designating the second sentence as para-
12	graph (3); and
13	(4) by inserting after the first sentence the fol-
14	lowing new paragraph:
15	"(2) Paragraph (1) shall not apply in the case of an
16	individual who has been determined to be a qualified medi-
17	care beneficiary (as defined in section $1905(p)(1)$) who is
18	residing in a skilled nursing facility, nursing facility, or
19	custodial care facility.".
20	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
21	subsection (a) apply to services furnished on or after Jan-
