2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME PERIOD FOR FILING CER-**
4 **TAIN COMPLAINTS UNDER PERISHABLE AG-**
5 **RICULTURAL COMMODITIES ACT, 1930.**

6 Section 6(a)(1) of the Perishable Agricultural Com-
7 modities Act, 1930 (7 U.S.C. 499f(a)(1)) is amended by
8 adding at the end the following: “Notwithstanding the pre-
9 ceding sentence, a person that desires to file a complaint
10 under this section involving the allegation of false inspec-
11 tion certificates prepared by graders of the Department
12 of Agriculture at Hunts Point Terminal Market, Bronx,
13 New York, prior to October 27, 1999, may file the com-
14 plaint until January 1, 2001.”.
