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## A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to provide for more equitable payments for direct graduate medical education under the Medicare Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Direct Graduate Med-  
5 ical Education Equity Act of 2000”.

1 **SEC. 2. FISCAL YEAR 2001 FLOOR SET AT 100 PERCENT OF**  
2 **LOCALITY ADJUSTED NATIONAL AVERAGE**  
3 **PER RESIDENT AMOUNT.**

4 (a) ESTABLISHING FY01 FLOOR AT 100 PER-  
5 CENT.—

6 (1) IN GENERAL.—Clause (iii) of section  
7 1886(h)(2)(D) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.  
8 1395ww(h)(2)(D)) is amended by striking “70 per-  
9 cent” and inserting “100 percent”.

10 (2) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—The heading  
11 of such clause is amended by striking “70 PERCENT”  
12 and inserting “100 PERCENT”.

13 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
14 subsection (a) shall apply as if included in the enactment  
15 of the Medicare, Medicaid, and SCHIP Balanced Budget  
16 Refinement Act of 1999 (Public Law 106–113).

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
