Mr. Hill of Montana introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To establish the boundaries and classification of a segment of the Missouri River in Montana under the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF BOUNDARIES OF SEGMENT OF UPPER MISSOURI WILD AND SCENIC RIVER, MONTANA.

(a) IN GENERAL.—For purposes of the Wild and Scenic River Act (16 U.S.C. 1271 et seq.)—

(1) the boundaries and classification of the Missouri River, Montana, segment designated by section

3(a)(14) of that Act (16 U.S.C. 1274(a)(14)) shall

1	be the boundaries and classification published in the
2	Federal Register on January 22, 1980 (45 Fed.
3	Reg. 4474–4478); and
4	(2) the management plan for such segment
5	shall be as set forth in—
6	(A) the Upper Missouri Wild and Scenic
7	River Management Plan, dated October 1978,
8	as updated in February 1993; and
9	(B) the West HiLine RMP/EIS Record of
10	Decision covering the Upper Missouri Wild and
11	Scenic River Corridor, dated January 1992.
12	(b) Revision of Boundaries, Classification,
13	AND MANAGEMENT PLAN.—This section shall not be con-
14	sidered to limit the authority of the Secretary of the Inte-
15	rior to revise the boundaries, classification, or manage-
16	ment plan for the Missouri River, Montana, segment re-
17	ferred to in subsection (a) after the date of the enactment
18	of this Act and in accordance with the Wild and Scenic
19	Rivers Act.
20	(c) Effective Date.—Subsection (a) shall be con-
21	sidered to have become effective on April 21, 1980.
