- 3 SECTION. 1. RECLASSIFICATION OF A CERTAIN COUNTY
- 4 FOR PURPOSES OF REIMBURSEMENT UNDER
- 5 THE MEDICARE PROGRAM.
- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 7 sion of law, effective for discharges occurring on or after
- 8 October 1, 2001, and before October 1, 2003, for purposes

- 1 of making payments under section 1886(d) of the Social
- 2 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395ww(d)) to hospitals in Lake
- 3 County, Indiana, such county is deemed to be located in
- 4 the Chicago, Illinois, Metropolitan Statistical Area.
- 5 (b) Construction.—For purposes of such section
- 6 1886(d), the reclassification under subsection (a) shall be
- 7 treated as a decision of the Medicare Geographic Classi-
- 8 fication Review Board under paragraph (10) of that sec-
- 9 tion.
