3 **SECTION 1. MAKING PERMANENT CERTAIN POLICING AU-**  
4 **THORITY.**

5 (a) **ELIMINATION OF SUNSET PROVISION AND RE-**  
6 **PORTING REQUIREMENT.**—Section 9 of the Act entitled  
7 “An Act relating to the policing of the building and

1 grounds of the Supreme Court of the United States”, ap-  
2 proved August 18, 1949 (40 U.S.C. 13n), is amended—

3 (1) by striking subsection (c); and

4 (2) by redesignating subsection (d) as sub-  
5 section (c).

6 (b) TECHNICAL AMENDMENT.—Section 9 of such Act  
7 is further amended in subsection (b) by striking “are au-  
8 thorized” and inserting “is authorized”.
