- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR SAEED

- 2 REZAI.
- 3 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
- 4 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
- 5 Act, Saeed Rezai shall be eligible for issuance of an immi-
- 6 grant visa or for adjustment of status to that of an alien
- 7 lawfully admitted for permanent residence upon filing an
- 8 application for issuance of an immigrant visa under sec-
- 9 tion 204 of such Act or for adjustment of status to lawful
- 10 permanent resident.
- 11 (b) Adjustment of Status.—If Saeed Rezai enters
- 12 the United States before the filing deadline specified in
- 13 subsection (c), he shall be considered to have entered and
- 14 remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligible, be eligi-
- 15 ble for adjustment of status under section 245 of the Im-
- 16 migration and Nationality Act as of the date of the enact-
- 17 ment of this Act.
- 18 (c) Deadline for Application and Payment of
- 19 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
- 20 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-
- 21 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees
- 22 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.
- 23 (d) Reduction of Immigrant Visa Number.—
- 24 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-
- 25 idence to Saeed Rezai, the Secretary of State shall instruct
- 26 the proper officer to reduce by 1, during the current or

- 1 next following fiscal year, the total number of immigrant
- 2 visas that are made available to natives of the country of
- 3 the alien's birth under section 203(a) of the Immigration
- 4 and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the total number of
- 5 immigrant visas that are made available to natives of the
- 6 country of the alien's birth under section 202(e) of such
- 7 Act.
- 8 (e) Denial of Preferential Immigration
- 9 Treatment for Certain Relatives.—The natural
- 10 parents, brothers, and sisters of Saeed Rezai shall not, by
- 11 virtue of such relationship, be accorded any right, privi-
- 12 lege, or status under the Immigration and Nationality Act.
