For the relief of Saeed Rezai.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR SAEED2REZAI.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a) and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality 4 5 Act, Saeed Rezai shall be eligible for issuance of an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status to that of an alien 6 7 lawfully admitted for permanent residence upon filing an 8 application for issuance of an immigrant visa under sec-9 tion 204 of such Act or for adjustment of status to lawful 10 permanent resident.

(b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Saeed Rezai enters
the United States before the filing deadline specified in
subsection (c), he shall be considered to have entered and
remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligible, be eligible
ble for adjustment of status under section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act as of the date of the enactment of this Act.

18 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF 19 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the application for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-20 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees 21 22 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act. 23 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.— 24 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent residence to Saeed Rezai, the Secretary of State shall instruct 25 26 the proper officer to reduce by 1, during the current or **HR 5266 RDS**

next following fiscal year, the total number of immigrant
 visas that are made available to natives of the country of
 the alien's birth under section 203(a) of the Immigration
 and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the total number of
 immigrant visas that are made available to natives of the
 country of the alien's birth under section 202(e) of such
 Act.

8 (e) DENIAL OF PREFERENTIAL IMMIGRATION 9 TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural 10 parents, brothers, and sisters of Saeed Rezai shall not, by 11 virtue of such relationship, be accorded any right, privi-12 lege, or status under the Immigration and Nationality Act.
