## A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "United States Mint
- 5 Numismatic Coin Clarification Act of 2000".
- 6 SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF MINT'S AUTHORITY.
- 7 (a) SILVER PROOF COINS.—Section 5132(a)(2)(B)(i)
- 8 of title 31, United States Code, is amended by striking
- 9 "paragraphs (1)" and inserting "paragraphs (2)".

1	(b) Platinum Coins.—Section 5112(k) of title 31,
2	United States Code, is amended by striking "bullion" and
3	inserting "platinum bullion coins".
4	SEC. 3. ADDITIONAL REPORT REQUIREMENT.
5	Section 5134(e)(2) of title 31, United States Code,
6	is amended—
7	(1) in the matter preceding subparagraph (A),
8	by striking "reflect" and inserting "contain";
9	(2) by striking "and" at the end of subpara-
10	graph (C);
11	(3) by striking the period at the end of sub-
12	paragraph (D) and inserting "; and; and
13	(4) by adding at the end the following new sub-
14	paragraph:
15	"(E) a supplemental schedule detailing—
16	"(i) the costs and expenses for the
17	production, for the marketing, and for the
18	distribution of each denomination of circu-
19	lating coins produced by the Mint during
20	the fiscal year and the per-unit cost of pro-
21	ducing, of marketing, and of distributing
22	each denomination of such coins; and
