AN ACT

To authorize the Frederick Douglass Gardens, Inc., to establish a memorial and gardens on Department of the Interior lands in the District of Columbia or its environs in honor and commemoration of Frederick Douglass.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. MEMORIAL AND GARDENS TO HONOR AND**
2 **COMMEMORATE FREDERICK DOUGLASS.**

3 (a) MEMORIAL AND GARDENS AUTHORIZED.—The
4 Frederick Douglass Gardens, Inc., is authorized to estab-
5 lish a memorial and gardens on lands under the adminis-
6 trative jurisdiction of the Secretary of the Interior in the
7 District of Columbia or its environs in honor and com-
8 memoration of Frederick Douglass.

9 (b) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-
10 RATIVE WORKS.—The establishment of the Frederick
11 Douglass memorial and gardens shall be in accordance
12 with the Commemorative Works Act (40 U.S.C. 1001 et
13 seq.).

14 (c) PAYMENT OF EXPENSES.—The Frederick Doug-
15 lass Gardens, Inc., shall be solely responsible for accept-
16 ance of contributions for, and payment of the expenses
17 of, the establishment of the memorial and gardens. No
18 Federal funds may be used to pay any expense of the es-
19 tablishment of the memorial and gardens.

20 (d) DEPOSIT OF EXCESS FUNDS.—If, upon payment
21 of all expenses of the establishment of the memorial and
22 gardens (including the maintenance and preservation
23 amount required under section 8(b) of the Commemora-
24 tive Works Act (40 U.S.C. 1008(b)), or upon expiration
25 of the authority for the memorial and gardens under sec-
26 tion 10(b) of such Act (40 U.S.C. 1010(b)), there remains

1 a balance of funds received for the establishment of the
2 memorial and gardens, Frederick Douglass Gardens, Inc.,
3 shall transmit the amount of the balance to the Secretary
4 of the Treasury for deposit in the account provided for
5 in section 8(b)(1) of such Act (40 U.S.C. 1008(b)(1)).
