3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Fairness and Vol-5 untary Arbitration Act".

1 SEC. 2. ELECTION OF ARBITRATION.

2 (a) SALES AND SERVICE CONTRACTS.—Chapter 1 of
3 title 9 of the United States Code is amended by adding
4 at the end thereof the following new section:

5 "§ 17. Sales and service contracts

6 "(a) For purposes of this section, the term 'sales and 7 service contract' means a contract under which any person 8 (including any manufacturer, importer or distributor) sells 9 any product to any other person for resale to an ultimate 10 purchaser and authorizes such other person to repair and 11 service such product.

12 "(b) Whenever a sales and service contract provides 13 for the use of arbitration to resolve a controversy arising 14 out of or relating to the contract, each party to the con-15 tract shall have the option, after the controversy arises 16 and before both parties commence an arbitration proceed-17 ing, to reject arbitration as the means of settling the con-18 troversy. Any such rejection shall be in writing.

"(c) Whenever arbitration is elected to settle a dispute under a sales and service contract, the arbitrator
shall provide the parties to the contract with a written
explanation of the factual and legal basis for the award.".

(b) TABLE OF CONTENTS.—The table of contents for
chapter 1 of title 9, United States Code, is amended by
adding at the end thereof the following new item:

"17. Sales and service contracts.".

1 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

2 The amendments made by section 2 shall apply to
3 contracts entered into, amended, altered, modified,
4 renewed, or extended after the date of the enactment of
5 this Act.
