9	end the following: "The limitation under subclause
10	(I) and the total number determined under sub-
11	clause (II) shall apply only to residents in the fields
12	of allopathic medicine or osteopathic medicine.".
13	(2) Conforming amendment.—The heading
14	of section $1886(h)(4)(G)$ of such Act (42 U.S.C.
15	1395ww(h)(4)(G)) is amended by inserting "IN
16	ALLOPATHIC AND OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE ONLY"
17	after "RESIDENTS AND INTERNS".
18	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
19	subsection (a) shall take effect as if included in the enact-
20	ment of the Balanced Budget Act of 1997 (Public Law
21	105–33).
