Mrs. MALONEY of New York (for herself, Mr. RANGEL, Mr. GONZALEZ, and Mr. FALDOMAVEGA) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Government Reform

A BILL

To amend title 13, United States Code, to provide that the term of office of the Director of the Census shall be 5 years, to require that such Director report directly to the Secretary of Commerce, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DIRECTOR OF THE CENSUS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 21 of title 13, United
5 States Code, is amended to read as follows:

1 **“§ 21. Director of the Census; duties; reporting**

2 “(a) The Bureau shall be headed by a Director of
3 the Census, appointed by the President, by and with the
4 advice and consent of the Senate. The Director shall per-
5 form such duties as may be imposed upon him by law,
6 regulations, or orders of the Secretary, and shall report
7 directly to the Secretary.

8 “(b) The term of office of the Director shall be 5
9 years, and shall begin on January 1, 2002, and every fifth
10 year thereafter. Any individual appointed to fill a vacancy
11 in such position occurring before the expiration of the
12 term for which his predecessor was appointed shall be ap-
13 pointed for the remainder of that term. The Director may
14 serve after the end of his term until reappointed or until
15 the appointment of a successor, but not for a period of
16 more than 180 days.”.

17 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
18 for chapter 1 of title 13, United States Code, is amended
19 by striking the item relating to section 21 and inserting
20 the following:

“21. Director of the Census; duties; reporting.”.

21 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

22 (a) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This Act shall take effect on
23 January 1, 2002.

24 (b) TRANSITION PROVISIONS.—If, upon the effective
25 date of this Act, the position of Director of the Census

1 would become vacant, the individual serving in that posi-
2 tion immediately before such effective date may continue
3 to serve as Director until either such individual or a suc-
4 cessor is appointed in accordance with the amendment
5 made by section 1(a), but not for a period of more than
6 180 days.
