1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. APPROVAL NOT REQUIRED TO VALIDATE LAND**
2 **TRANSACTIONS.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Notwithstanding any other provi-
4 sion of law, without further approval, ratification, or au-
5 thorization by the United States, the Coushatta Tribe of
6 Louisiana, may lease, sell, convey, warrant, or otherwise
7 transfer all or any part of the Tribe’s interest in any real
8 property that is not held in trust by the United States
9 for the benefit of the Tribe.

10 (b) **TRUST LAND NOT AFFECTED.**—Nothing in this
11 section is intended or shall be construed to—

12 (1) authorize the Coushatta Tribe of Louisiana
13 to lease, sell, convey, warrant, or otherwise transfer
14 all or any part of an interest in any real property
15 that is held in trust by the United States for the
16 benefit of the Tribe; or

17 (2) affect the operation of any law governing
18 leasing, selling, conveying, warranting, or otherwise
19 transferring any interest in such trust land.
