- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans' Families
- 5 Protection Act of 2000".

1	SEC. 2. DEPENDENCY AND INDEMNITY COMPENSATION
2	FOR SURVIVING SPOUSES AND CHILDREN OF
3	CERTAIN VETERANS WITH A SERVICE-CON-
4	NECTED DISABILITY THAT WAS CONTINU-
5	OUSLY RATED TOTALLY DISABLING FOR A
6	PERIOD OF ONE OR MORE YEARS IMME-
7	DIATELY PRECEDING DEATH.
8	Subsection (b) of section 1318 of title 38, United
9	States Code, is amended by striking "rated totally dis-
10	abling if—" and all that follows through the end of the
11	subsection and inserting "that was continuously rated to-
12	tally disabling for a period of one or more years imme-
13	diately preceding death.".
