A BILL

To declare the policy of the United States with respect
to deployment of a National Missile Defense System.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Security Against Nu-
5 clear Enemies Act of 2000”.

6 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL MISSILE DEFENSE POLICY.**

7 The Secretary of Defense shall direct the Director of
8 the Ballistic Missile Defense Organization to design and
9 deploy a land-based and sea-based National Missile De-

1 fense system capable of defending the national territory
2 of the United States against ballistic missile attack as
3 soon as technologically possible.
