A BILL

To ensure the availability of funds for ergonomic protection
standards.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS FOR ERGONOMIC**
4 **PROTECTION STANDARDS.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, up to
6 \$50,000,000 of the amounts otherwise appropriated to the
7 Occupational Safety and Health Administration for fiscal
8 year 2001 shall be available for the promulgation,
9 issuance, implementation, administration, and enforce-

- 1 ment of proposed, temporary, and final standards on ergo-
- 2 nomic protection.
