3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION.**

4 The comment periods on the proposed rules related
5 to clothes washers published at 65 Federal Register
6 59549–59588 (October 5, 2000) and the proposed rules
7 related to residential central air conditioners and heat
8 pumps published at 65 Federal Register 59589–59632

1 (October 5, 2000) shall both be extended from December
2 4, 2000, for a period of not less than 120 additional cal-
3 endar days.
