A BILL

To repeal section 8003 of Public Law 105–174.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Home Page Tax Re-
5 peal Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL.**

7 (a) REPEAL.—Section 8003 of the 1998 Supple-
8 mental Appropriations and Rescissions Act (112 Stat. 93)
9 is repealed.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The repeal made by sub-
2 section (a) shall be effective as of April 30, 1998.

3 **SEC. 3. USE OF FUNDS.**

4 The National Science Foundation may use funds ap-
5 propriated for fiscal year 1999 to meet any obligations re-
6 sulting from the enactment of this Act.

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
