## A BILL

To amend the Marine Protection, Research, and Sanctuaries Act of 1972 relating to the dumping of dredged material in Long Island Sound, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Long Island Sound  
3 Preservation and Protection Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. DUMPING OF DREDGED MATERIALS IN LONG IS-**  
5 **LAND SOUND.**

6 Section 106(f) of the Marine Protection, Research,  
7 and Sanctuaries Act of 1972 (33 U.S.C. 1416(f)) is  
8 amended to read as follows:

9 “(f) **DUMPING OF DREDGED MATERIAL IN LONG**  
10 **ISLAND SOUND.—**

11 “(1) **IN GENERAL.—**No dredged material from  
12 any Federal project, or from any non-Federal  
13 project, that contains any of the constituents prohib-  
14 ited as other than trace contaminants (as defined by  
15 the Federal ocean dumping criteria set forth in sec-  
16 tion 227.6 of title 40 of the Code of Federal Regula-  
17 tions) may be dumped in Long Island Sound or  
18 Block Island Sound, except in cases in which it is  
19 demonstrated to the Administrator, and the Admin-  
20 istrator certifies by publication in the Federal Reg-  
21 ister, that the dumping of the dredged material con-  
22 taining such constituents will not cause significant  
23 undesirable effects, including the threat associated  
24 with bioaccumulation of such constituents in marine  
25 organisms.

1           “~~(2)~~ FEDERAL PROJECTS EXCEEDING 25,000  
2           YARDS.—In addition to other provisions of law and  
3           notwithstanding the specific exclusion relating to  
4           dredged material in the first sentence in section  
5           102(a), any dumping of dredged material in Long  
6           Island Sound from a Federal project (or pursuant to  
7           Federal authorization) by a non-Federal applicant  
8           exceeding 25,000 cubic yards shall comply with the  
9           criteria established pursuant to the second sentence  
10          of section 102(a) relating to the effects of dumping.

11          “~~(3)~~ RELATION TO OTHER LAW.—Subsection  
12          (d) shall not apply to this subsection.”.

13   **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

14          *This Act may be cited as the “Long Island Sound Pres-*  
15          *ervation and Protection Act”.*

16   **SEC. 2. DUMPING OF DREDGED MATERIALS IN LONG IS-**  
17          **LAND SOUND.**

18          *Section 106(f) of the Marine Protection, Research, and*  
19          *Sanctuaries Act of 1972 (33 U.S.C. 1416(f)) is amended*  
20          *to read as follows:*

21          “*(f) DUMPING OF DREDGED MATERIAL IN LONG IS-*  
22          *LAND SOUND.—In addition to other provisions of law, the*  
23          *transportation of dredged material from—*

24                  “*(1) a dredging project exceeding 25,000 cubic*  
25                  *yards by a non-Federal applicant;*

1           “(2) any dredging project by a Federal appli-  
2           cant; or

3           “(3) any Federal project,  
4 for the purpose of dumping it into the waters of Long Island  
5 Sound (including Fisher’s Island Sound) must satisfy all  
6 applicable provisions of this title as if the waters of Long  
7 Island Sound, which are internal waters of the United  
8 States, were ocean waters under this title.”.
