To amend the Communications Act of 1934 to exempt licenses in the instructional television fixed service from competitive bidding.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION. 1. EXEMPTION FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING.**

4 Section 309(j)(2) of the Communications Act of 1934
5 (47 U.S.C. 309(j)(2)) is amended—

6 (1) by striking “or” at the end of subparagraph
7 (B);

8 (2) by striking the period at the end of sub-
9 paragraph (C) and inserting “; or”; and

1 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
2 paragraph:

3 “(D) for stations in the instructional tele-
4 vision fixed service.”.
