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**AN ACT**

To amend title 49, United States Code, to extend Federal Aviation Administration programs through September 30, 1999, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Airport Improvement  
3 Program Short-Term Extension Act of 1999”.

4 **TITLE I—EXTENSION OF FED-**  
5 **ERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRA-**  
6 **TION PROGRAMS**

7 **SEC. 101. AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.**

8 (a) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section  
9 48103 of title 49, United States Code, is amended by  
10 striking “\$1,205,000,000” and all that follows through  
11 the period at the end and inserting the following:  
12 “\$2,410,000,000 for fiscal years ending before October 1,  
13 1999.”.

14 (b) OBLIGATIONAL AUTHORITY.—Section 47104(c)  
15 is amended by striking “March 31, 1999” and inserting  
16 “September 30, 1999”.

17 **SEC. 102. AIRWAY FACILITIES IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.**

18 Section 48101(a) of title 49, United States Code, is  
19 amended by adding at the end the following:

20 “(3) \$2,131,000,000 for fiscal year 1999.”.

21 **SEC. 103. FAA OPERATIONS.**

22 (a) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FROM  
23 GENERAL FUND.—Section 106(k) of title 49, United  
24 States Code, is amended by striking “\$5,158,000,000”  
25 and all that follows through the period at the end and

1 inserting the following: “\$5,632,000,000 for fiscal year  
2 1999.”.

3 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FROM  
4 TRUST FUND.—Section 48104(c) of such title is  
5 amended—

6 (1) in the subsection heading by striking “FIS-  
7 CAL YEARS 1994–1998” and inserting “FISCAL  
8 YEARS 1994–2000”; and

9 (2) in the matter preceding paragraph (1) by  
10 striking “through 1998” and inserting “through  
11 2000”.

12 (c) LIMITATION ON OBLIGATING OR EXPENDING  
13 AMOUNTS.—Section 48108(c) of such title is amended by  
14 striking “1998” and inserting “2000”.

15 **SEC. 104. AIP DISCRETIONARY FUND.**

16 Section 47115 of title 49, United States Code, is  
17 amended—

18 (1) by striking subsection (g); and

19 (2) by redesignating subsection (h) as sub-  
20 section (g).

1 **TITLE II—EXTENSION OF AIR-**  
2 **PORT AND AIRWAY TRUST**  
3 **FUND EXPENDITURE AU-**  
4 **THORITY**

5 **SEC. 201. EXTENSION OF EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Paragraph (1) of section 9502(d)  
7 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (relating to expendi-  
8 tures from Airport and Airway Trust Fund) is amended—

9 (1) by striking “October 1, 1998” and inserting  
10 “October 1, 1999”; and

11 (2) by inserting before the semicolon at the end  
12 of subparagraph (A) the following: “or the Omnibus  
13 Consolidated and Emergency Supplemental Appro-  
14 priations Act, 1999 or the Airport Improvement  
15 Program Short-Term Extension Act of 1999”.

16 (b) LIMITATION ON EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.—  
17 Section 9502 of such Code is amended by adding at the  
18 end the following new subsection:

19 “(f) LIMITATION ON TRANSFERS TO TRUST FUND.—

20 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in para-  
21 graph (2), no amount may be appropriated or cred-  
22 ited to the Airport and Airway Trust Fund on and  
23 after the date of any expenditure from the Airport  
24 and Airway Trust Fund which is not permitted by  
25 this section. The determination of whether an ex-

1       penditure is so permitted shall be made without re-  
2       gard to—

3               “(A) any provision of law which is not con-  
4               tained or referenced in this title or in a revenue  
5               Act; and

6               “(B) whether such provision of law is a  
7               subsequently enacted provision or directly or in-  
8               directly seeks to waive the application of this  
9               subsection.

10              “(2) EXCEPTION FOR PRIOR OBLIGATIONS.—  
11       Paragraph (1) shall not apply to any expenditure to  
12       liquidate any contract entered into (or for any  
13       amount otherwise obligated) before October 1, 1999,  
14       in accordance with the provisions of this section.”.
