# RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 417) to amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to reform the financing of campaigns for elections for Federal office.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution,  
2 the House immediately shall consider the bill (H.R. 417)  
3 to amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to  
4 reform the financing of Federal elections. The first read-  
5 ing of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order  
6 against the bill and against its consideration are waived.  
7 The bill shall be considered as read for amendment. The  
8 bill shall be debatable for two hours equally divided and

1 controlled by Mr. Campbell and a member opposed to the  
2 bill. The previous question shall be considered as ordered  
3 on the bill to final passage without intervening motion ex-  
4 cept one motion to recommit.

5       SEC. 2. It shall not be in order for the House to con-  
6 sider a resolution which waives or supersedes any provi-  
7 sion of this resolution.
