Mr. Bonior submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of H.R. 325.

- 1 Resolved, That immediately upon the adoption of this
- 2 resolution the House shall resolve into the Committee of
- 3 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
- 4 ation of the bill (H.R. 325) to amend the Fair Labor
- 5 Standards Act of 1938 to increase the Federal minimum
- 6 wage. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with.
- 7 All points of order against consideration of the bill are
- 8 waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and
- 9 shall not exceed 2 hours, equally divided and controlled
- 10 by the Chairman and Ranking Member of the Committee
- 11 on Education and the Workforce. After general debate the
- 12 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-

- 1 minute rule. The bill shall be considered as read. At the
- 2 conclusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the
- 3 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with
- 4 such amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
- 5 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
- 6 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
- 7 motion except one motion to recommit with instructions.
- 8 Sec. 2. (a) The Clerk shall not prepare the engross-
- 9 ment of H.R. 325 until the 30th calendar day following
- 10 its passage. If, before such 30th calendar day, the House
- 11 has passed a bill introduced by Representative Rangel of
- 12 New York and Representative Tanner of Tennessee relat-
- 13 ing to tax relief for small businesses, then the Clerk shall
- 14 prepare immediately the engrossment of H.R. 325 in the
- 15 form described in subsection (b).
- 16 (b) If the bill described in subsection (a) is passed
- 17 by the House within the time period described in sub-
- 18 section (a), the Clerk, in the engrossment of H.R. 325,
- 19 shall—
- 20 (1) add at the end of the text of H.R. 325, as
- 21 passed by the House, the text of the bill described
- in subsection (a), as passed by the House;
- 23 (2) conform the title of H.R. 325 to reflect the
- addition of the bill described in subsection (a) to its
- engrossment;

1 (3) assign appropriate designations to provi2 sions within the engrossment; and
3 (4) conform provisions for short titles within
4 the engrossment.
5 (c) Upon the addition of its text to the engrossment
6 of H.R. 325, the bill described in subsection (a) shall be
7 laid on the table.
