Mrs. Myrick, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2436) to amend title 18, United States Code, and the Uniform Code of Military Justice to protect unborn children from assault and murder, and for other purposes.

- 1 Resolved, That at any time after the adoption of this
- 2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
- 3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
- 4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
- 5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2436) to amend title 18, United
- 6 States Code, and the Uniform Code of Military Justice

to protect unborn children from assault and murder, and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be 3 dispensed with. Points of order against consideration of the bill for failure to comply with clause 3(b) of the rule XIII are waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed two hours equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member 8 of the Committee on the Judiciary. After general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-10 minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute 12 rule the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on the Judiciary now printed in the bill. The committee amendment in the nature of 14 15 a substitute shall be considered as read. No amendment to the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute 16 17 shall be in order except those printed in the report of the 18 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each 19 amendment may be offered only in the order printed in 20 the report, may be offered only by a Member designated 21 in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debat-22 able for the time specified in the report equally divided 23 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division of the question in the House or in

- 1 the Committee of the Whole. The Chairman of the Com-
- 2 mittee of the Whole may: (1) postpone until a time during
- 3 further consideration in the Committee of the Whole a re-
- 4 quest for a recorded vote on any amendment; and (2) re-
- 5 duce to five minutes the minimum time for electronic vot-
- 6 ing on any postponed question that follows another elec-
- 7 tronic vote without intervening business, provided that the
- 8 minimum time for electronic voting on the first in any se-
- 9 ries of questions shall be 15 minutes. At the conclusion
- 10 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
- 11 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
- 12 amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member may
- 13 demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment
- 14 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to
- 15 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute.
- 16 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
- 17 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
- 18 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
- 19 or without instructions.
