Mr. DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 1993) to reauthorize the Overseas Private Investment Corporation and the Trade and Development Agency, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1993) to reauthorize the Overseas

1 Private Investment Corporation and the Trade and Devel-
2 opment Agency, and for other purposes. The first reading
3 of the bill shall be dispensed with. General debate shall
4 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-
5 ly divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
6 nority member of the Committee on International Rela-
7 tions. After general debate the bill shall be considered for
8 amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order
9 to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amend-
10 ment under the five-minute rule an amendment in the na-
11 ture of a substitute consisting of the bill modified by the
12 amendments recommended by the Committee on Inter-
13 national Relations now printed in the bill. Each section
14 of that amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be
15 considered as read. No amendment to that amendment in
16 the nature of a substitute shall be in order except those
17 printed in the portion of the Congressional Record des-
18 ignated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII and
19 except pro forma amendments for the purpose of debate.
20 Each amendment so printed may be offered only by the
21 Member who caused it to be printed or his designee and
22 shall be considered as read. The Chairman of the Com-
23 mittee of the Whole may: (1) postpone until a time during
24 further consideration in the Committee of the Whole a re-
25 quest for a recorded vote on any amendment; and (2) re-

1 duce to five minutes the minimum time for electronic vot-
2 ing on any postponed question that follows another elec-
3 tronic vote without intervening business, provided that the
4 minimum time for electronic voting on the first in any se-
5 ries of questions shall be 15 minutes. At the conclusion
6 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
7 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
8 amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member may
9 demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment
10 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to
11 the amendment in the nature of a substitute made in order
12 as original text. The previous question shall be considered
13 as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final
14 passage without intervening motion except one motion to
15 recommit with or without instructions.
