6 read for amendment. In lieu of the amendments rec-  
7 ommended by the Committees on Agriculture and Com-  
8 merce now printed in the bill, the amendment in the na-  
9 ture of a substitute printed in the report of the Committee  
10 on Rules accompanying this resolution shall be considered  
11 as adopted. The previous question shall be considered as  
12 ordered on the bill, as amended, to final passage without  
13 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate on the  
14 bill, as amended, equally divided among and controlled by  
15 the chairmen and ranking minority members of the Com-  
16 mittees on Agriculture and Commerce; and (2) one motion  
17 to recommit with or without instructions.
