The previous question shall be considered as 12 ordered on the bill, as amended, to final passage without 13 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate on the bill, as amended, equally divided among and controlled by 14 15 the chairmen and ranking minority members of the Committees on Agriculture and Commerce; and (2) one motion 16 to recommit with or without instructions. 17
