Mr. DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4461) making appropriations for Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies programs for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2001, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-

1 ation of the bill (H.R. 4461) making appropriations for
2 Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Adminis-
3 tration, and Related Agencies programs for the fiscal year
4 ending September 30, 2001, and for other purposes. The
5 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points
6 of order against consideration of the bill are waived. Gen-
7 eral debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-
8 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair-
9 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on
10 Appropriations. After general debate the bill shall be con-
11 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule. When
12 the reading for amendment reaches title VIII, that title
13 shall be considered as read. Points of order against provi-
14 sions in the bill for failure to comply with clause 2 of rule
15 XXI are waived except as follows: page 74, line 19,
16 through page 75, line 4; page 84, line 21, through page
17 96, line 4. During consideration of the bill for amendment,
18 the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may accord
19 priority in recognition on the basis of whether the Member
20 offering an amendment has caused it to be printed in the
21 portion of the Congressional Record designated for that
22 purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed
23 shall be considered as read. The Chairman of the Com-
24 mittee of the Whole may: (1) postpone until a time during
25 further consideration in the Committee of the Whole a re-

1 quest for a recorded vote on any amendment; and (2) re-
2 duce to five minutes the minimum time for electronic vot-
3 ing on any postponed question that follows another elec-
4 tronic vote without intervening business, provided that the
5 minimum time for electronic voting on the first in any se-
6 ries of questions shall be 15 minutes. At the conclusion
7 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
8 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
9 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
10 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
11 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
12 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
13 structions.
