3 order to consider in the House the joint resolution (H.J.
4 Res.115) making further continuing appropriations for
5 the fiscal year 2001, and for other purposes. The joint
6 resolution shall be considered as read for amendment. The
7 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the

1 joint resolution to final passage without intervening mo-
2 tion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and
3 controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member
4 of the Committee on Appropriations; and (2) one motion
5 to recommit.

6 SEC. 2. Upon the adoption of this resolution it shall
7 be in order without intervention of any point of order to
8 consider in the House the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 116)
9 making further continuing appropriations for the fiscal
10 year 2001, and for other purposes. The joint resolution
11 shall be considered as read for amendment. The previous
12 question shall be considered as ordered on the joint resolu-
13 tion to final passage without intervening motion except:
14 (1) one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by
15 the chairman and ranking minority member of the Com-
16 mittee on Appropriations; and (2) one motion to recommit.

18 be in order without intervention of any point of order to
19 consider in the House the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 117)
20 making further continuing appropriations for the fiscal
21 year 2001, and for other purposes. The joint resolution
22 shall be considered as read for amendment. The previous
23 question shall be considered as ordered on the joint resolu-
24 tion to final passage without intervening motion except:
25 (1) one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by

1 the chairman and ranking minority member of the Com-

22 (1) one hour of debate of equally divided and controlled
23 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the
24 Committee on Appropriations; and (2) one motion to re-
25 commit.

3 consider in the House the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 120)
4 making further continuing appropriations for the fiscal
5 year 2001, and for other purposes. The joint resolution
6 shall be considered as read for amendment. The previous
7 question shall be considered as ordered on the joint resolu-
8 tion to final passage without intervening motion except:
9 (1) one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by
10 the chairman and ranking minority member of the Com-
11 mittee on Appropriations; and (2) one motion to recommit.
