- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. CLASSIFICATION AS A CHILD UNDER THE IMMI-
- 4 GRATION AND NATIONALITY ACT.
- 5 (a) In General.—In the administration of the Im-
- 6 migration and Nationality Act, Regine Beatie Edwards
- 7 shall be classified as a child within the meaning of section
- 8 101(b)(1)(E) of such Act, upon approval of a petition filed
- 9 on her behalf by Stan Edwards, a citizen of the United
- 10 States, pursuant to section 204 of such Act.
- 11 (b) LIMITATION.—No natural parent, brother, or sis-
- 12 ter, if any, of Regine Beatie Edwards shall, by virtue of

- 1 such relationship, be accorded any right, privilege, or sta-
- 2 tus under the Immigration and Nationality Act.
