 States, pursuant to section 204 of such Act.

3 (b) LIMITATION.—No natural parent, brother, or sis4 ter, if any, of Regine Beatie Edwards shall, by virtue of
5 such relationship, be accorded any right, privilege, or sta6 tus under the Immigration and Nationality Act.
