- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.
- 4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
- 5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
- 6 1101 et seq.), Mrs. Elizabeth Eka Bassey and her chil-
- 7 dren, Emmanuel O. Paul Bassey, Jacob Paul Bassey, and
- 8 Mary Idongesit Paul Bassey, shall be held and considered
- 9 to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for

- 1 permanent residence as of the date of the enactment of
- 2 this Act upon payment of the required visa fees.

## 3 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.
