## AN ACT

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Alabama.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## 1 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE AND REINSTATE-

- 2 MENT OF LICENSE.
- 3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the time period
- 4 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16
- 5 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal En-
- 6 ergy Regulatory Commission project numbered 7115, the
- 7 Commission shall, at the request of the licensee for the
- 8 project, in accordance with the good faith, due diligence,
- 9 and public interest requirements of that section and the
- 10 Commission's procedures under that section, extend for 3
- 11 consecutive 2-year periods, the time period during which
- 12 the licensee is required to commence construction of the
- 13 project.
- 14 (b) Applicability.—Subsection (a) shall take effect
- 15 on the expiration of the period required for commencement
- 16 of construction of the project described in subsection (a).
- 17 (c) Reinstatement of Expired License.—If the
- 18 license for the project described in subsection (a) has ex-
- 19 pired prior to the date of enactment of this Act, the Com-
- 20 mission shall reinstate the license effective as of the date
- 21 of its expiration and extend the time required for com-
- 22 mencement of construction of the projects for not more

- 1 than 3 consecutive 2-year periods, the first of which shall
- 2 commence on the date of expiration of the license.
