## **AN ACT**

To establish a Chief Agricultural Negotiator in the Office of the United States Trade Representative.

## 1 SECTION 1. CHIEF AGRICULTURAL NEGOTIATOR.

(a) ESTABLISHMENT OF A POSITION.—There is established the position of Chief Agricultural Negotiator in
the Office of the United States Trade Representative. The
Chief Agricultural Negotiator shall be appointed by the
President, with the rank of Ambassador, by and with the
advice and consent of the Senate.

8 (b) FUNCTIONS.—The primary function of the Chief 9 Agricultural Negotiator shall be to conduct trade negotia-10 tions and to enforce trade agreements relating to U.S. ag-11 ricultural products and services. The Chief Agricultural Negotiator shall be a vigorous advocate on behalf of U.S. 12 13 agricultural interests. The Chief Agricultural Negotiator shall perform such other functions as the United States 14 15 Trade Representative may direct.

(c) COMPENSATION.—The Chief Agricultural Negotiator shall be paid at the highest rate of basic pay payable
to a member of the Senior Executive Service.
