AN ACT

To amend the Federal Report Elimination and Sunset Act of 1995.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Federal Reports Elimi-
- 5 nation and Sunset Act Amendments of 1999".

1 SEC. 2. CLARIFICATION OF SCOPE OF SUNSET.
