## A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to eliminate an inequity in the applicability of early retirement eligibility requirements to military reserve technicians.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

**3 SECTION 1. EQUITABLE APPLICATION OF EARLY RETIRE-**

4 MENT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS TO MILI5 TARY RESERVE TECHNICIANS.

6 (a) TECHNICIANS COVERED BY FERS.—Paragraph 7 (1) of section 8414(c) of title 5, United States Code, is 8 amended by striking "after becoming 50 years of age and 9 completing 25 years of service" and inserting "after completing 25 years of service or after becoming 50 years of
 age and completing 20 years of service".

3 (b) TECHNICIANS COVERED BY CSRS.—Section
4 8336 of title 5, United States Code, is amended by adding
5 at the end the following new subsection:

6 "(p) Section 8414(c) of this title applies—

"(1) under paragraph (1) of such section to a
military reserve technician described in that paragraph for purposes of determining entitlement to an
annuity under this subchapter; and

"(2) under paragraph (2) of such section to a
military technician (dual status) described in that
paragraph for purposes of determining entitlement
to an annuity under this subchapter.".

(c) TECHNICAL AMENDMENT.—Section 1109(a)(2)
of Public Law 105–261 (112 Stat. 2143) is amended by
striking "adding at the end" and inserting "inserting after
subsection (n)".

(d) APPLICABILITY.—Subsection (c) of section 8414
of such title (as amended by subsection (a)), and subsection (p) of section 8336 of title 5, United States Code
(as added by subsection (b)), shall apply according to the
provisions thereof with respect to separations from service

- 1 referred to in such subsections that occur on or after Octo-
- 2 ber 5, 1999.
