## **AN ACT**

For the relief of Malia Miller.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR MALIA 4 MILLER.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
6 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
7 Act, Malia Miller shall be eligible for issuance of an immi8 grant visa or for adjustment of status to that of an alien
9 lawfully admitted for permanent residence upon filing an

application for issuance of an immigrant visa under sec tion 204 of such Act or for adjustment of status to lawful
 permanent resident.

4 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Malia Miller enters 5 the United States before the filing deadline specified in 6 subsection (c), she shall be considered to have entered and 7 remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligible, be eligi-8 ble for adjustment of status under section 245 of the Im-9 migration and Nationality Act as of the date of enactment 10 of this Act.

(c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the application for issuance of an immigrant visa or the application for adjustment of status are filed with appropriate
fees within 2 years after the date of enactment of this
Act.

17 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.-Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-18 idence to Malia Miller, the Secretary of State shall in-19 20 struct the proper officer to reduce by one, during the cur-21 rent or next following fiscal year, the total number of im-22 migrant visas that are made available to natives of the 23 country of the alien's birth under section 203(a) of the 24 Immigration and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the 25 total number of immigrant visas that are made available

1 to natives of the country of the alien's birth under section

 $2 \quad 202(e)$  of such Act.
