3 **SECTION 1. FULL OBLIGATION AUTHORITY FOR INDIAN**
4 **RESERVATION ROADS PROGRAM.**

5 Section 1102(c)(1) of the Transportation Equity Act
6 for the 21st Century (23 U.S.C. 104 note; 112 Stat. 116)
7 is amended—

8 (1) by striking “Code, and” and inserting
9 “Code,”; and

1 (2) by inserting before the semicolon at the end
2 the following: “, and, for each of fiscal years 2001
3 through 2003, amounts authorized for Indian res-
4 ervation roads under section 204 of title 23, United
5 States Code”.
