## A BILL

To amend title XXI of the Social Security Act to increase the allotments for territories under the State Children's Health Insurance Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INCREASED ALLOTMENTS FOR TERRITORIES**  
4 **UNDER THE STATE CHILDREN'S HEALTH IN-**  
5 **SURANCE PROGRAM.**

6 Section 2104(c)(4)(B) of the Social Security Act (42  
7 U.S.C. 1397dd(c)(4)(B)), as added by the Omnibus Con-  
8 solidated and Emergency Supplemental Appropriations  
9 Act, 1999 (Public Law 105-277), is amended by inserting  
10 “, \$34,200,000 for each of fiscal years 2000 and 2001,

---

- 1 \$25,200,000 for each of fiscal years 2002 through 2004,
- 2 \$32,400,000 for each of fiscal years 2005 and 2006, and
- 3 \$40,000,000 for fiscal year 2007” before the period.
